No — Norwegian Cruise Line (NCL) Future Cruise Credits (FCC) Are NOT Refundable as Cash

### What FCC Actually Means

A Future Cruise Credit (FCC) from Norwegian Cruise Line is NOT a cash refund to your bank account. Instead, it is:

- A travel credit issued by NCL
- Only usable for future NCL cruise bookings
- Stored in your NCL passenger account
- Valid for a specific timeframe (check your terms)

### Can You Convert FCC into Cash Refund?

 Normally: NO


FCC Facts	Reality
Refundable as Cash?	 No

FCC = Locked for future NCL travel only.

### Rare Exceptions (When Cash Might Be Possible)

You may convert FCC to cash only in these limited cases:

Once FCC is issued, it usually stays as credit – no cash conversion.
